FOREST SCHOOL

Forest School is a form of outdoor education where we use the environment as a teacher. We work to foster rich learning experiences through nature connections for children in the early years. We believe that children not only need, but deserve nature in their everyday lives.

We strive to create an environment where children are free to be curious, are able to explore the world around them through wonder and inquiry, all the while building strong and healthy relationships with themselves, their peers, and the natural world. Our forest school is operated in a play based and child led learning style.

We offer forest school for two age groups, 4-6 year olds and 7-10 year olds. Both these programs explore learning and developing different skills and abilities.



SUMMER DAY CAMP

Natures Calling offers day camps for ages 4-10. Campers can look forward to an amazing and fun adventure every single day of camp.

Each day starts with a gathering circle to plan our day. This is followed by activities that combine each week's theme, along with plenty of games, crafts, exploration and free play. At the end of the day we gather again to talk about what our favourite part of the day was and say our goodbyes for another day.

Summer camp runs July through August and March break camp falls on the School Boards designated break in March.



FOREST PRE SCHOOL

Forest Preschool is a outdoor early childcare program for three year olds that allows children develop important skills all while being outdoors in nature.

Forest Preschool fosters an environment to allow children to learn to problem solve, communicate, self regulate and build confidence in themselves and develop abilities through play and experiences.

Children spend the day going for hikes, exploring, catching bugs, listening to stories and participating in different crafts and activities. This program is child led and play based on the children's natural interest and curiosity.
